This week I have created some art tasks along with the remaining 5 English tasks and I have added some tricky maths puzzles below for you to have a go at. As I said in my previous letter, it is important that some kind of routine is found and regular breaks are timetabled in throughout the day. I suggest doing small bursts of learning in different subjects and then regular short breaks too –this will allow children to remain focused.

Maths:

I have selected a couple of tricky puzzles for you to have a go at, don't worry if you can answer them straight away just keep having a go and you will get there 😊

Rows of coins



1. Take five coins: 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p.
Put them in a row using these clues.
The total of the first three coins is 27p.
The total of the last three coins is 31p.
The last coin is double the value of the first coin.
2. Take six coins: two 1p, two 2p and two 5p.
Put them in a row using these clues.
Between the two 1p coins there is one coin.
Between the two 2p coins there are two coins.
Between the two 5p coins there are three coins.

What if you take two 10p coins as well, and between them are four coins?

English:

Keep using Bugclub (Active Learn), Lexia, Fiction Express and Spelling Shed as this helps with the grammar and spelling elements of the curriculum really well.

This week I'd like you to complete the remaining tasks from our booklet 'The Truth About Trolls'. There are 5 tasks that can be split into one task a day or the tasks can be grouped together depending on what works best for your family.

For this week please can you read the report and complete the activities on pages 13 –18. The five tasks are called the following in the document:

1. Drop-in Game (Page 13)
2. Writing some new information about trolls (Page 14)
3. Planning out your own information on trolls (Page 15)
4. Writing your own information text on trolls (Page 16)
5. Evaluating your English work so far (Pages 17 and 18)

Different levels of support will be needed to complete these activities so use your judgement on how much support you need to give your child to complete the tasks.
