

During Summer term we discussed and came up with different ideas that are important to us as a school and our local community in order to start a campaign. The top 3 ideas we discussed were:

1. Dog poo bins to be located on the main walking routes to school for example - the track from Burton woods. This will keep our community and around our school gates clean.
2. Contacting delivery companies that deliver to our school to cut back on plastic and packaging.
3. Looking to install a defibrillator within the local community of Spennymoor.

School council are keen to take forward and start a campaign to try and see if we would be eligible for funding for a defibrillator within the local area. We are going to work with RRS on the campaign and discuss ideas virtually.
