

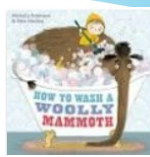
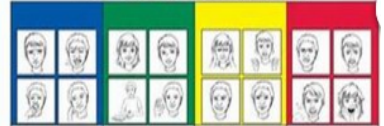

English

In English the children will be developing their reading, writing, speaking and listening skills using the stimulus of our class texts and our Stone Age topic. The first texts will be 'Stone Age Boy' and 'How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth.' We will be writing setting descriptions, stories and instructions using these texts.

Mathematics

In Maths, children will be concentrating on mastering their basic skills of place value, addition and subtraction and will use these to solve a wide range of problems. We are learning to use numbers up to 1000 and consolidating our addition and subtraction skills. Every week, we will continue to work on our multiplication tables targets, and our arithmetic skills.
